A message from the Treasurer.

IAM Membership - A Clarification

It seems there may be some confusion regarding membership of IAM RoadSmart, ata national and group level; hopefully this will clear matters up.

When an advanced driving course (previously called Skill for Life) is bought, the recipient becomes an Associate Member. The fee to IAM RoadSmart (£149) includes your first year's (national) membership, test fee, administration & insurance costs, and also a payment to the group to which you will be affiliated – in this case, the Leicester Group. That payment to the group covers their administrative costs and the first year's (local) membership fee – in our case \pounds 7.50, but not all groups charge the same annual membership fee.

Once you pass your test, you become a Full Member and, to continue membership of IAM RoadSmart, you must pay an annual fee on the anniversary of your joining IAM. The amount will vary depending on your level of membership (Fellow or Member) and, if paid by Direct Debit or card, attracts a discount. You will receive an annual membership card; this does not mean that you have paid and normally states that it is valid WHEN the fee is paid. If you do not pass your test within a year of becoming an Associate, IAM will ask for a 2nd year's national membership fee from you.

To continue to be a member of the Leicester Group once you have passed your test, an annual fee is also due, as stated above, presently at £7.50, in addition to your national membership fee. This is due on 01 April each year and can be paid by Standing Order (*), Bank Transfer (*), Cheque (+) or cash. We previously also ran an "anniversary" system but changed to the annual system in 2018. Any Standing Orders should reflect the new date, 01 April. Reminders that membership payments are due will the sent out in the newsletter.

Police Update

Police Spring Update.

Vehicle Tax

Police have assisted the DVLA during their national March 'Vehicle Tax' campaign. In the last 12 month the LE postcode alone has had over 22,000 tax inquiries – it's a big problem and often includes other traffic offences.

Roadworks

Two major schemes are starting on the A5 between the M69 and the A4303 Cross in Hand. These are at Magna Park where a new island is being constructed and the other is between the M69 and the B678 just south of the Hinckley Island hotel. Both schemes will have narrow lanes and a temporary 40 mph speed limit will be in place. There will be some night closures.

Campaigns

During April the Force will participate in the NPCC Mobile Phone campaign. We have a real distraction problem on our hands which all forces are finding difficult to tackle. This is resulting in many injury accidents sometimes fatal.

During May we shall be concentrating on two wheelers. Regrettably Leicestershire and other forces in our region have dealt with several fatalities in 2019. Apart from publicity including the social media we will be patrolling key motorcycle routes in Leicestershire and Rutland during the next 6 months.

Safer Roads Team

Made up of officers from the Road Policing Unit and Special Constabulary. The team has conducted a number of operations since formation and has done sterling work at our speed complaint sites. Several arrests for various offences have been made.
