Police Update

Some very good news from our Road Safety Partnership (RSP). Casualties On Our Roads Are Down.

In 2017 Leicestershire Police dealt with the lowest number of casualties on our roads ever recorded.

Of the 2219 casualties 20 were fatalities, 276 serious and 1923 slight injury.

Compared to 2016 this represents:

A reduction of

- 23 Fatals (53.4%)
- 34 Serious (11%)
- 648 Slight (25.2%)

Our roads are becoming safer but there are still high levels of traffic non-compliance. This was illustrated on 21st May in a 3 hour Fatal4 operation in Loughborough when nearly 40 drivers were dealt with for non use of the seat belt, using the mobile phone and a number of miscellaneous offences.

There is still much work for the RSP to get on with and several more Fatal4 events across the policing area are in the pipeline.

Drink/Drug-Drive Campaign

Our campaign starts on 1st June and it will take in the World Cup which commences on 14th June concluding on 15th July.

After our media launch we will be carrying out a number of operations screening drivers for alcohol and drugs. The latter is a growing road safety issue which we are tackling by training more officers to carry out the tests. We will be encouraging people to enjoy themselves throughout the tournament whilst not engaging in drink-driving. The outcome of the campaign will be made known in due course.

Mobile Phones

The RSP is promoting the Defender Signal Blocker. This is a device to prevent a phone from receiving any calls or alerts, leaving a driver free to fully focus on the road ahead; no distractions, no notifications.

Once in the sealed pouch the signal is blocked within 5 seconds and returns within the same time period once removed.

Distraction is a major collision factor across Europe that needs to be tackled.
