A message from the Treasurer.

Group Subscriptions

If you have recently passed your IAM RoadSmart test, this specifically applies to you!!

The £149.00 you pay to IAM RoadSmart for the advanced driving package includes administrative fees, your test fee and the first year's membership – both nationally and for your local group. The group also receives a sum to cover any administrative and observer costs they may incur. At the end of your first year as a member you will need to renew your national membership AND your group membership –whether or not you have yet passed your test. IAM HQ will contact you directly regarding your national subscription, Group subscriptions are notified by the Newsletter. Our subs are due annually on 01st April, regardless of when you joined IAM RoadSmart and are £7.50 – this is paid to the group and is separate from your national subscription. If you wish to be an Observer and/or Committee member, both your national and group memberships must be current.

GDPR

In view of GDPR and the contract recently sent to you, I will be conducting a data cleanse of the membership database early in the New Year. I will delete ALL members, of whatever grade, that have not paid Group Subscriptions since 31st December 2015. Recently qualified full members need to read the article about Group Subscriptions. The new, significantly reduced email list will be passed to Kevin for future issues of the Newsletter.
