Car tax 2017 and 2018

2017

In April <u>car tax rules changed</u> introduced higher first year one off payments and standardised second year fees.

Under the new rules only all-electric cars costing under £40,000 would not have to pay tax.

Any car with a value over £40,000 faces paying a £310 surcharge on top of their car at cost.

Second year standard rate charges will vary for drivers depending on what type of car and the fuel used.

-£140 per year for petrol and diesel vehicles

-£130 per year for 'alternative fuel' vehicles, such as hybrids

-£0 per year for zero emissions vehicles, such as fully electric

The government has announced plans for a consultation aimed at improving moped and motorcycle training, the closing date for you to view has gone (February 2017) but I thought it would be interesting to read the draft proposals. First year 'licence rate' (based on the vehicle's emissions) 120g/km - £160 150g/km - £200

170g/km - £500

Over 255g/km - £2,000

In the Autumn Budget Chancellor Philip Hammond revealed that <u>diesel car owners</u> would face paying up to a band higher car tax if their cars do not meet the emissions standard.

This could add up to £500 a year on the first year rate of car tax.

For example to tax a car which emits 160g/km of CO2 you pay £200 for the first year, but under the new tax rules you'd pay £500.

Mark Winn, Head of Motorcycling Policy at the Driver and Vehicle Standards Agency (DVSA), has outlined a nine point plan, which includes:

EU speeding laws

On May 7, British motorists <u>caught</u> <u>speeding in Europe could face £640 fine</u>s, due to a new Brussels rule.

Member states have been given powers to track down UK motorists and hand them the fines, if an offence is made.

Report on November's 2017 meeting

The Speaker at our November meeting was Simon Burgin, who is a serving police traffic officer and collision investigator for Cambridgeshire Police.

His presentation was well attended and generated a great deal of interest and debate. Simon covered all aspects of collision investigations including a detailed explanation of how the process is carried out on site and how new technology has speeded up the time it takes to complete. In the past, many photographs had to be taken and measurements made by hand. New laser scanning equipment creates a virtual 3d colour image of the whole scene with as few as three scans from different spots.

Simon is also a qualified drone operator and uses a drone to take photographs and video of collision scenes from the air. The new technology significantly speeds up time on scene gathering evidence and enables roads to be reopened more quickly. His talk was illustrated with photographs and videos. It was both fascinating but at times harrowing.

We hope that he will be able to come again during 2018 and share more of his knowledge and experience with us.
